- Ruth and Michelle followed up with quotes from Stead Construction <u>ryan@stead.co.nz</u>, GEM Group <u>brent.mcasey@gemgroup.com</u> and Michelles son PA BUILD – Whetu Ferris. Feedback was - Brent and Ryan said the job was too small for them while Whetu produced a reasonable invoice. Attached are pictures of the floor that were sent to builders for their quotes.
- The pipe on the inside chiller was leaking which caused the floor issue. Ruth had Adam from Coldrite come in to look at the chiller and he fixed the pipe. An invoice is still to be received.
- Coldrite also supplied a quote for the outside chiller/freezer. \$6327.71 Invoice (See attached).
- Michelle used her initiative and supplied a list of further work to be done for our marae wharekai to be usable. See attached a Job list.
- Solutions were discussed and the Committee is happy for Michelle to get PABUILD (Whetu) to see to these jobs. Already today the boys were at the marae measuring up the container.
- It was agreed by the Committee that we use up to \$10,000 for this fix. Michelle and Ruth will monitor costs accordingly. We expect the work to be done within the month.

• We have a behavioural issue with Lawrence Hapi and need to have a new plan regarding the marae grounds work. We have also found that the cost to maintain the tractor has been costly over the past 12 months. We are looking to sell the Tractor and get a contractor to do the marae lawns.

- The world is going away from payments by cheque and we are now looking to use an online banking option.


